Revenues

In Fiscal Year 2008 (ending 30 June) worldwide gross revenues of PwC's network of firms increased 8 per cent at constant exchange rates to a record 28.2 billion USD. At variable rates of exchange revenues grew by 14 per cent.

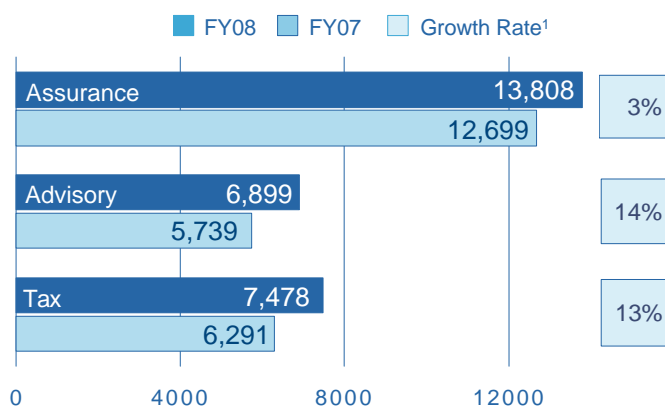
